Joe Keneally: on June 4th there will be a Public Hearing on placing a 1 year moratorium on BESS facilities. He then introduced Eric Koglin of the Town Zoning Review Committee.

Eric Koglin gave a short verbal resume and was on hand to hear out the Fire Department's concern on the BESS facilities.

Paul Coneski: Noted the fact that the proposed location of these facilities are probably in the worst locations for them, on Maple Ave. adjacent to and across from a Medical facility and Apartment complex; On Route 50 again behind a Medical facility and Surgical Center and near crowded Route 50.

Note above no active fire personnel were present

Nash Alexander: Did not have any numbers or drawings yet for the upgrade and/or rebuild of the Squad building. Spring Fire/EMS shows were keeping the Architects busy.

Exit 15 Auto Park Documents were received by the Emergency Squad, their only concerns were of vehicle clearance and access points. It was assumed that Fire personnel are reviewing their sets.

Topics from floor: Paul Coneski noted the review of the Nuisance Alarm Code, he felt the fines a little low, they should be stiffer than the cost of having a technician come out and look into the reason for the alarm. But felt the decision should be made by the active personnel.
